

Notification dated 7th October 1981

Order

2-1-81-FSH (v)

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980 (3 of 1981), the Government of Goa, Daman and Diu having regard to the need to protect the interest of different those engaged in fishing using traditional fishing crafts, such as, catamaran, country craft or a canoe, hereby prohibits fishing with mechanized fishing vessels from 7.00 p.m. to 5.00 a.m. in the area specified in the Government Notification No. 2-1-81-FSH (iii) dated 7-7-1981, published in the Official Gazette Series I, No. 15 dated 9-7-1981.

Explanation: In this Order, the expression "Mechanised fishing vessel" means a fishing vessel propelled by mechanical means.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Indian Fisheries Act, 1897 (Central Act 4 of 1897), the Lieutenant Governor of Goa, Daman and Diu hereby applies all rules of the Goa, Daman and Diu Fisheries Rules 1981 published in the Official Gazette, Series I, No.18, dated 30.07.1981, to all waters, not being private waters i.e. creek, river, canal, stream or any other water course wherein fishing is possible, stationary water collected in a paddy field or khazan land wherein fishing is possible and the sea along the coast of the Union territory of Goa Daman and Diu upto a distance of 5 kms. from the coast with effect from the date of the publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.
