S.R.O. No. 1065 / 91—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Kerala Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980 (Act 10 of 1981) read with rule 4 of the Kerala Marine Fishing Regulation Rules, 1980, the Government of Kerala here by cancel Notification G.O. (P) No. 31 / 91 / F&PD dated 12th July, 1991 published as S.R.O. No. 925 / 91 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 863 dated the 12th July, 1991.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of this notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

Government have received representations from various Associations and persons in the fisheries sector requesting that the period of ban may be reduced. It was brought to the Government's notice that workers engaged on the mechanized boats and those employed in the peeling sheds and processing units were in distress during the period the ban was in operation, because trawling could not be carried out. The Ministry of Commerce, Government of India and the Marine Products Export Development Authority, Kochi also requested reduction of the period of ban in order to ensure that exports are not affected. Taking all these requests into consideration and also the fact that the mechanized boats could not go out to the sea for a number of days during the month of June because of heavy monsoons and rough sea, Government now feel that the ban imposed as per G.O. (P) No. 31 / 91 / F&PD dated 12 / 7 / 91 may be lifted. Hence the notification.
