In view of the trawl ban imposed by the Government of Kerala it has been decided to impose a ban on operation of deepsea fishing vessels from Cochin Port. This ban will be operative for a period of 45 days starting 15<sup>th</sup> June, 1995. These deepsea fishing vessels would be required to shift their base port elsewhere during the period of enforcement of this ban. For this purpose, they would be allowed to move their vessels out as soon as possible, to an alternative base port, under intimation to this Ministry.
