ORDER

In view of the trawl ban imposed by the Government of Kerala it has been decided to impose a ban on operation of deep sea fishing vessels from Cochin Port in water of Kerala Coast. This ban will be operative for a period of 45 days commencing from 15. 6. 96. As such, all deep sea fishing vessels operating from the Cochin port would be required to shift their base port elsewhere during the period of this ban. For this purpose, they would be allowed to move their vessels to an alternative base port, under intimation to this Ministry.
