In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 28 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980 (Act 3 of 1981) and all the other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following Rules so as to further amend the Goa, Daman and Diu Marine Fishing Regulation Rules, 1982, as follows, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement : - (1) These Rules may be called Goa Marine Fishing Regulation (Amendment) Rules, 2001.

- (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of Rule 3.— In Rule 3 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Marine Fishing Regulation Rules, 1982 (hereafter called the Principal Rules) (i) for Sub-Rule (1) the following shall be substituted, namely:-
- "(1) Every Owner of Fishing Vessel shall make an application accompanied by the fees as specified in the Table below to the Authorised Officers for Grant or Renewal of Licence in Form 'A'."

- "(5) Licence issued will be valid for one year and will have to be renewed annually by paying renewal fees specified in Sub-Rule (1)".
- 3. Amendment of rule 6—- In Rule 6 of the principal rules, (1) for sub-rule (2), the following shall be substituted namely:—
- (2) Every application under Sub-Rule (1) shall be accompanied with the fees as specified in the table below namely:—

(7) Every application for issue of duplicate registration certificate shall be supported with the copy of Police FIR in case of loss of certificate in the case of damage of the certificate and shall be accompanied with fee of Rs. 100/-".
