NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (1) of section 24 of the Andhra Pradesh Marine Fishing (Regulation) Act. (Act No. 9 of the 1995). The Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to the Andhra Pradesh Marine Fishing (Regulation) Rules, 1995 issued in G.O. Ms. No. 26, Animal Husbandry & Fisheries (Fish. I) Dept., dated 13th March 1996 and the same was published in Rules supplement to part I extraordinary issue of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette No. 36-A dated the 23rd of July, 1996 and as amended subsequently from time to time.

AMENDMENT

In the said rules: -

1. In rule 10 for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted: namely: -

“(1) In case the owner of the registered fishing vessel fails to obtain licence or to pay the fees for renewal of licence by the date stipulated under rules, he shall be liable to pay

licence fee prescribed for the respective categories as specified under the Table in rule 8(1) plus a penalty for the period of delay as follows:

| <u>Period or late payment</u> | <u>Penalty</u> |
|--|----------------------------------|
| 1 st July to 30 th September | 1/4 th of licence fee |
| 1 st October to 31 st December | 2/4 th of licence fee |
| 1 st January to 31 st March | 3/4 th of licence fee |
| 1 st April to 30 th June | Double the licence fee". |

II. In rule 12, -

For item (1) of sub clause (ii) of clause (a) of sub-rule (1), the following shall be substituted namely; "(1) Which is engaged in fishing in the reserved zone for traditional crafts i.e., 8 K.M. from the shore and impose a fine the five times of the value of the fish seized subject to minimum of Rs.5.000/-",

(2) For sub-rule (9), the following shall be substituted; namely: -

"(9) The Authorised Officer should also issue identification cards to all the crew of vessel concerned. Further, the crew of the fishing vessel shall have to obtain the identify cards from the Authorised Officer by furnishing of two recent passport size photographs to the Authorised Officer on payment of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only) per identify card in case of loss of identify card, a duplicate identify card can be obtainable on payment of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty only) after thorough verification of the facts to the satisfaction of the Authorised Officer".

(3) After sub rule (9), the Following shall be added; namely: -

"(10) The Authorised Officer should also issue a seaworthy certification for the motorized /beach landing craft and traditional craft and their accessories in Form VII to the boat owners for the purpose of the enclosing the same along with the application in Form III for the issue of licence. However, the seaworthy certificate issued by the Port Department shall be valid for the mechanized fishing vessels".

III After Form No VI, the following shall be added, namely;

FORM VII

See rule 12 (10)

This is to certify that the fishing boat bearing regulation No _____ has been checked by me on this day..... and it is found that the fishing boat in carrying all the components required for the sea going and the condition of boat is seaworthy. This certificate is valid for one year from the date of issue.
