5. WEATHER IN SRI LANKA




6. USEFUL DETAILS

Travel Adapter


When traveling to Sri Lanka, you will need a travel adapter as the country primarily uses **Type G plugs** (three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern), with some areas also having Type D plugs (three round pins in a triangular pattern); the standard voltage is 230V and 50Hz frequency, so check your electronics are compatible before plugging in.



The nearest Supermarket is the Laugfs supermarket




For medical emergencies, the maps to the nearest **medical centre** and **pharmacy** are given below:



7. FIELD TRIP: NEGOMBO LAGOON

Negombo Lagoon is a large estuarine lagoon in Negombo, south-west Sri Lanka, known for its fishing activity. It is 12 km in length from south to north and 3.75 km at its widest point, and about 1.2 m deep. It is one of the most productive and sensitive ecosystems in Sri Lanka with fresh water input from the rivers Dandugam Oya and Ja-ela. The lagoon and its coastal environment have been known for fish production. Altogether 89 species of benthic invertebrates, 29 mangrove species, seven sea grass species and 140 species of fish have been recorded. The lagoon and the adjacent reef areas function as the major nursery, refuge and feeding grounds for most of shrimp species.
